WHAT TO BRING

Everyone needs to bring a sleeping bag or bedding, pillow, toiletries, sneakers, **BIBLE**, and clothes for varying weather conditions. **Students are allowed to bring their cell phones to camp.**

WHAT NOT TO BRING

NO mp3 players/ipods, or laptops are allowed to be used at camp.

All inappropriate and prank items will be confiscated.

There is a **zero tolerance** for any weapons, alcohol, tobacco, or drugs.

SNACK SHOP

Hamburgers, Hot Dogs, Ice Cream, Soda, Candy and other delicious items are available at a reasonable cost.

A reasonable amount for each camper to bring for the Snack Shop is \$20-\$40.

All monies are the sole responsibility of each camper.

CONDUCT & DRESS CODE

Everyone will be open to the incredible things God has in store!

Campers will be expected to treat everyone and their property with respect and consideration.

There is a zero tolerance policy regarding public displays of affection, sexual contact, alcohol, tobacco, illicit drugs, weapons, gambling, pranks and invasion of other's property or living space. Campers and their parents/guardians will be financially responsible for any and all property damage directly resulting from inappropriate behavior.

Modesty in dress will be expected. The following guidelines must be adhered to:

- Clothing must completely cover all bra straps and under clothing
- Tops/Shirts must cover the front and sides of the torso and abdomen.
- Tank Tops must have a minimum 1" wide strap across the shoulders and cover under clothing
- Shorts must be longer than each person's finger tips when fully extended at the side
- Ladies must wear one piece bathing suits or tankinis that fully cover the abdomen (NO BIKINIS)
- Guys must wear modest bathing trunks, no speedo type suits allowed
- No clothing permitted that references tobacco, alcohol, drugs, immoral behavior or rude comments including related insignias or advertisements.

Campers wearing inappropriate clothing will be asked to change into something more suitable.
